Mile- point	Directions	Notes/Points of Interest
0.0	North on Fir St from intersection with Washington St	Scenic Bikeway route starts at the northeast corner of Village Green Park – drinking water, restrooms, showers. Bikeway closed due to snow each winter. Route open to motor free traffic as snow melts until mid-June each year. Visit www.tripcheck.com for seasonal openings
0.1	Left on Hood Ave	
0.6	Left on OR-242/Old McKenzie Hwy	
4.4	Continue on OR-242	Cold Springs Campground (USFS) - camping, water, restrooms
7.8	Continue on OR-242	McGregor's Curve - caution, sharp turn on downhill
8.8	Continue on OR-242	East Snow Gate - OR-242/McKenzie Hwy closed seasonally
11.8	Continue on OR-242	Windy Point - interpretive displays, scenic vistas
14.6	Continue on OR-242	Lava Lake Campground (USFS) left 0.5 mile on rough road - camping, restroom, no potable water
15.1	Continue on OR-242	McKenzie Pass Summit - 5,325 feet
15.2	Continue on OR-242	Dee Wright Observatory - Interpretive displays, historic lookout, restrooms
21.1	Continue on OR-242	Scott Lake Campground (USFS) right 0.7 miles on gravel - camping, restrooms, no potable water
23.6	Continue on OR-242	Caution - Sharp corners, minimal shoulder next 5 miles
26.7	Continue on OR-242	Alder Springs Campground (USFS) - camping, restrooms, no potable water
28.2	Continue on OR-242	Proxy Falls trailhead - restrooms
30.6	Continue on OR-242	White Branch Snow Gate - OR-242/McKenzie Hwy closed seasonally
35.6	Continue on OR-242	Limberlost Campground (USFS) - camping, restrooms, no potable water
37.0	Right on OR-126/McKenzie Hwy	
38.0	Route ends at Belknap Hot Springs	Camping, restaurant, store, water, parking are available at Belknap Hot Springs (private)
